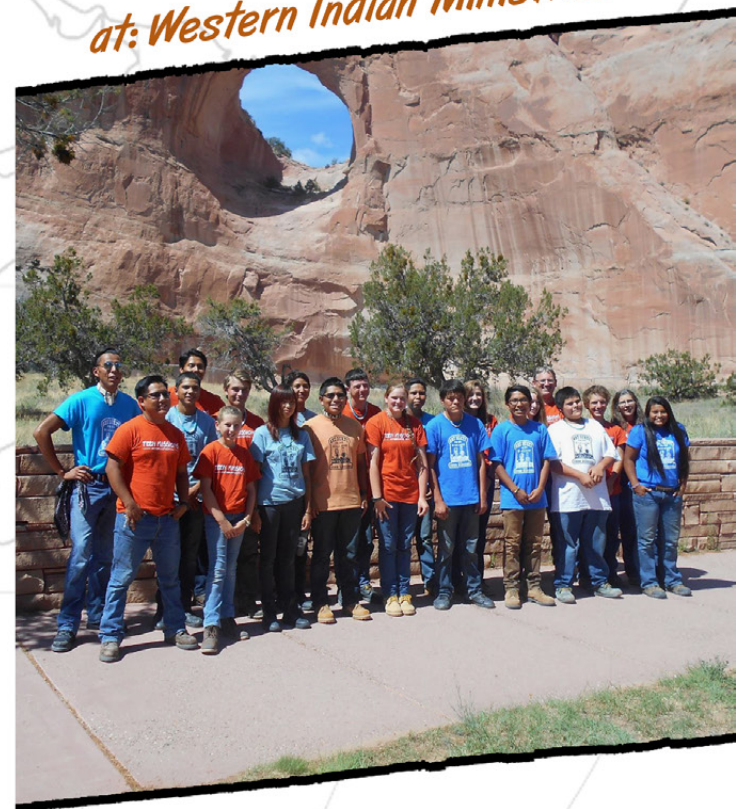

# Native American Boot Camp

*at: Western Indian Ministries*

## HISTORY

- Teen Missions has trained and sent out more than 80,000 teens from over 20 countries on short-term missions trips since 1970. Now, for the first time, Native American youth can join together to **make a difference** serving the Lord on exciting work and evangelistic teams.

- Teen Missions is an interdenominational evangelical organization working with established evangelical churches. Teen Missions does not stress any specific doctrine other than a standard evangelical interdenominational position.



## BOOT CAMP

- Team members and leaders are trained for 10 days at the Lord's Boot Camp, hosted at **Western Indian Ministries** near Window Rock. They will be trained in their spiritual walk as well as in basic construction skills. They will also learn to share God's love through puppets, drama, songs, and testimonies.

- During **Boot Camp** (training) all members will participate in an Obstacle Course each morning which will help team members work together as a team. Personal devotions, Scripture memory, Bible study and evening rallies are a part of the training. Teams will then travel to their **Project** locations for three weeks of ministry involving work and evangelism. They will then return to Window Rock for **Debrief**.



**NOTE:** BOOT CAMP training is not easy. Housing is in tents. Be sure to come prepared.



## COST

Leaders and team members are responsible for transportation to Boot Camp and transportation home after Debrief. You are also responsible for the registration fee, personal spending money, and medical expenses. Food and housing (during the dates listed) will be provided by Teen Missions.



## DATES

Leader Arrival Day: Monday, June 19  
 Team Member Arrival Day: Saturday, June 24  
 Go Home Day: Sunday, July 30

Teen applicants must be Native American and agree to attend for the full dates of involvement. They will NOT be permitted to return home for forgotten items or have their families bring them.



## REGISTRATION

You **MUST** register online and pay the registration fee of \$10 in order to confirm your reservation to Teen Missions Indian Boot Camp.

Registration **MUST** be completed **BEFORE** Arrival Day. Team members must be 13-19 years old and need to bring a signed permission form from their parents or legal guardian. They should have a desire to grow in the Lord and be willing to obey their leaders and cooperate with their team. If a team member does not cooperate, they will be sent home.
